

OFFICIAL CALL
Mass Meeting of the
Nottoway County Republican Committee

As Chairman of the Nottoway County Republican Committee (NCRC), of the Republican Party of Virginia, and pursuant to the Plan of Organization and, as recommended and directed by the Unit Committee, I, William Berry, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Mitchell's Restaurant, Main Street, Blackstone, Virginia 23824, starting at 6:00 PM local time on Thursday, 2 April, for the following purposes:

- a) To elect a Unit Chairman
- b) To reconstitute the membership of the Nottoway County Republican Committee.
- c) To elect a Unit Vice-Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer
- d) For the transaction of such business as may properly come before the committee.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of the NCRC under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion national origin or sex, and who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing, as may be required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions, or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

Military Members who declare via electronic mail to the Chairman of the Official Committee calling for the Convention or his designee in the Call, that because of the obligation of their official military orders, they are unable to attend the respective Unit Mass Meeting, Canvass or Convention called for the purpose of selecting delegates to that Convention, and that in lieu of selecting delegates to represent them from their respective Unit they instead wish to be represented by the Military Delegation, shall be entitled to representation via the Military Delegation. Such e-mail declaration shall

include attached a signed statement of intent and affirmation of their official military orders precluding their attendance, and their e-mail address for correspondence. The Call for the Convention shall provide Military Members the deadline and e-mail address by which to send their declarations. The Chairman of his designee shall respond via e-mail to each Military Member to confirm the receipt of such e-mail declaration.

Filing Requirements

Candidates for election for Unit Chairman and other Officers at said mass meeting shall file a written statement (Pre-files) in person that must be received before the Mass Meeting (Mitchell's Restaurant) by 5:00 PM 2 April, 2026. Pre-files will be sent to Tyler Scott at tylernscott@yahoo.com.

If only one candidate properly files, then said candidate shall be declared the winner.

Registration will begin at 6:00 PM on 14 March 2026.

Filing for Unit Membership and Delegates

Individuals applying for membership shall submit the attached membership form which must be mailed or delivered in person to William Berry, 401 6th Street, Blackstone, VA 23824 by 27 March 2026 at 5:00 PM. Registration Fees

There is no registration fee to participate in the Mass Meeting: however, you will not be able to vote for Officers unless you are a Committee Member.

All individuals attending the Mass Meeting shall present a valid government issued photo ID at registration.
