

OFFICIAL CALL  
Mass Meeting  
Of Louisa County Republican Committee Of the Republican Party of Virginia

As Chairman of the Louisa County Committee of the Republican Party of Virginia, pursuant to the Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Roger Clifton, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at Betty Queen Center 522 Industrial Dr. Louisa Va 23093 or its alternate site, starting at 6:30 P.M., Thursday, May 21, 2026. Registration begins at 6:00 P.M. and ends at 6:30 P.M. for the following purposes:

1. Electing a Unit Chairman;
2. Electing members to the Louisa County Republican Committee
  - A. Registration will begin at 6:00 P.M. local time.
  - B. No proxies will be allowed.
  - C. Any person in line at 6:30 P.M. will be allowed to register.
  - D. People arriving after 6:30 P.M. will not be allowed to register or vote.
  - E. All participants shall present a government issued photo ID at the time of registration.
3. If only one person is properly filed for Chairman, that person may be declared elected. and the Mass Meeting may be cancelled.

#### Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Louisa County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as may be required their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the November 5, 2026 election may, as members of the Republican Party of Virginia, be elected as delegates to the Mass Meeting, subject to the provisions in Article I of the Plan of Organization.

Mass meeting participants must present one of the forms of identification listed in § 24.2-643 of the Code of Virginia to participate as a voting member at the mass meeting.

#### Filing Requirements

Candidates for election or nomination at this Mass Meeting (Committee Membership, Unit Chair) shall file the proper forms in person or by mail to – for Committee Membership, Brent Whitlock, 2382 Rock Quarry Road, Louisa, Virginia 23093 – for Unit Chair, Bruce Stone, 9723 Jefferson Highway, Mineral. Virginia 23117. The statement for committee membership /or Unit Chair must be made on the Louisa County GOP official filing form, which is available from Brent Whitlock or Bruce Stone. All fees must accompany forms. All fees shall be made out to the Louisa County Republican Committee. Candidates for election as Chairman of the Louisa County Republican Committee must file the written statement on the Louisa County GOP official form with a non-refundable check in the amount of \$300.00, handed to Bruce Stone or mailed to 9723 Jefferson Highway, Mineral, Virginia 23117, by May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at 5:00 P.M; postmarks do not govern. Checks for the filing fee shall be made out to the Louisa County Republican Committee. Chairman is for a term

of 2 years or until his successor shall be elected. There will be no nominations from the floor accepted.

Candidates for election as a MEMBER of the Louisa County Republican Committee must file the written statement on the Louisa County GOP official form with a check in the amount of \$25 for one- year membership, by Friday, May 14,2026 at 5:00 P.M. Forms may be handed to or mailed to Brent Whitlock, 2382 Rock Quarry Road, Louisa Va. 23093.

Postmarks do not govern.

If not more than the number of persons to be nominated or elected shall file for any office, then such properly filed persons may be declared nominated or elected. Should all elections be cancelled, the Mass Meeting may also be cancelled. A notice of cancellation will be posted on the website of the Republican Party of Virginia, [virginia.gop](http://virginia.gop).
