

Louisa County Republican Committee Mass Meeting

As Chairman of the **Louisa County Republican Committee**, pursuant to the Republican Party Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, **Roger Clifton**, do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at the Betty Queen Center, 522 Industrial Drive, Louisa VA, 23093, or an alternative site as determined by the Chairman, starting at **6:30 PM** local time on **Friday, September 14, 2026**. Registration begins at **6:00 PM**.

The purpose of this mass meeting is electing up to **520** Delegates and an equal number of Alternate Delegates to the Fifth Congressional District Republican Convention, to be held on Saturday, November 14 at the Thomas Gymnasium at Fork Union Military Academy at 4744 James Madison Highway, Fork Union, VA 23055 or an alternate site, if necessary, for the purpose of electing a District Committee Chair and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the Convention.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of **Louisa County**, under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nominating process of a party, other than the Republican Party, in the last five years from March 1, 2021. A single exception to this restriction shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that they are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future.

Fifth District Republican Conventions Delegate Filing Requirements

Delegate candidates for election at said mass meeting shall pre-file a separate application for the Fifth District Republican Convention along with the mandatory \$20.00 delegate filing fees by **September 4, 2026 at 6:00 PM**. Completed applications and delegate filing fees are to be mailed or hand delivered to **Roger Clifton, 20282 Louisa Road, Louisa, VA, 23093**. Postmarks do not govern, and it is the responsibility of the delegate to confirm receipt of application with the Chair. Available phone number to verify the delivery of application is **(703)895-9203**. The delegate application form for the Fifth District Republican Convention is attached to this call. **(NOTE: Make sure you attached the approved delegate filing form as there is only one official form.)**

The Fifth Congressional District Republican Committee is requiring a \$20.00 filing fee from all individuals seeking election as a delegate or alternate delegate to the Fifth Congressional District Republican Convention. A separate check needs to be made out to the “**Louisa County Republican Committee**”. Cash can be accepted.

Military Members as Delegates

Military Members (any members of the Virginia National Guard, or the United States Armed Forces, Merchant Marine, or Coast Guard currently serving on active duty) may be certified as delegates by complying with the procedures detailed in a Unit's call pursuant to Art. VIII, Sec. H, para. 6.

Military Member delegates or alternate delegates that are unable to attend the convention in person due to obligations of their official military orders, shall have their votes cast within their unit delegation according to candidate preference ballots.

Resolutions

Resolutions shall not be considered at this Mass Meeting.

Registration Fee

There will be no registration fee to participate in this Mass Meeting.

Cancellation Notification

Should no more than **520** delegates pre-file for the Fifth District Republican Convention by the deadline, then those candidates shall be duly elected by acclamation, and the mass meeting shall be cancelled.
