

Prince Edward County Republican Committee Mass Meeting

As Chairman of the Prince Edward County Republican Committee pursuant to the Republican Party Plan of Organization and as recommended and directed by the Committee, I, Carolyn Bowman do hereby issue this call for a Mass Meeting to be held at 100 Dominion Drive Farmville, VA 23901, or an alternative site as determined by the Chairman, starting at 7:00 PM local time on Tuesday, September 15, 2026. Registration begins at 6:00 PM local time.

The purpose of this mass meeting is electing up to 165 Delegates and an equal number of Alternate Delegates to the Fifth Congressional District Republican Convention, to be held on Saturday, November 14, 2026, at 10:00 AM at the Thomas Gymnasium at Fork Union Military Academy, 4744 James Madison Highway, Fork Union, VA 23055 or an alternate site, if necessary, for the purpose of electing a District Committee Chair.

Qualifications for Participation

All legal and qualified voters of Prince Edward County under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, regardless of race, religion, national origin or sex, who are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and who, if requested, express in open meeting either orally or in writing as required, their intent to support all of its nominees for public office in the ensuing election, may participate as members of the Republican Party of Virginia in its mass meetings, party canvasses, conventions or primaries encompassing their respective election districts.

In addition to the foregoing, to be in accord with the principles of the Republican Party, a person otherwise qualified hereunder shall not have participated in Virginia in the nominating process of a party other than the Republican Party in the last five years from March 1, 2021. A single exception to this restriction shall be approved for a voter that renounces affiliation with any other party in writing, and who expresses in writing that they are in accord with the principles of the Republican Party and intends to support the nominees of the Republican Party in the future.

Fifth District Republican Conventions Delegate Filing Requirements

Delegate candidates for election at said mass meeting shall pre-file a separate application for the Virginia and/or Fifth District Republican Conventions along with the mandatory delegate filing fees by Friday September 11, 2026, at 4:00 PM. Completed applications and delegate filing fees are to be mailed or hand delivered to Stan Smith at Farmville Wholesale Electric Supply Co., Inc., 301 W 3rd St, Farmville, VA 23901 or to Carolyn Bowman at The Farmer's Daughters, 24120 Prince Edward Hwy, Rice, VA 23966. Postmarks do not govern, and it is the responsibility of the delegate to confirm receipt of application with the Chair. Available email to verify the delivery of application is chair@pecvagop.org. The delegate application form for the Fifth District Republican Convention is attached to this call.

The Fifth Congressional District Republican Committee is requiring a \$20 filing fee from all individuals seeking election as a delegate or alternate delegate to the Fifth Congressional District Republican Convention. A separate check needs to be made out to the "Prince Edward County Republican Committee". Cash can be accepted.

Resolutions

Resolutions shall not be considered at this Mass Meeting.

Military Members as Delegates

Military Members (any members of the Virginia National Guard, or the United States Armed Forces, Merchant Marine, or Coast Guard currently serving on active duty) may be certified as delegates by complying with the procedures detailed in a Unit's call pursuant to Art. VIII, Sec. H, para. 6.

Military Member delegates or alternate delegates that are unable to attend the convention in person due to obligations of their official military orders, shall have their votes cast within their unit delegation according to candidate preference ballots.

Registration Fee

There will be NO registration fee to participate in this Mass Meeting.

Cancellation Notification

Should no more than 165 delegates pre-file for the Fifth District Republican Convention by the deadline, then those candidates shall be duly elected by acclamation, and the mass meeting shall be cancelled.
